Parts Manager

A Part's Managers role is to maximise efficiency and profitability from the Parts Department. Parts Managers work in franchised or non-franchised garages with workshops, or in specialist Servicing or Body Repair Companies or in Motor Factor Outlets. A Parts Manager will often assist the Parts Technicians in their work. Applicants interested in pursuing a career in Parts Department Management should ideally have worked as a member of a Parts Department within a dealership for at least 5 years and must be over 18 years of age. Applicants must also have a minimum requirement 5 Passes in Ordinary Papers at Leaving Certificate level or equivalent qualifications or relevant sales or management experience.

The primary functions of a Parts Manager include:

- People Management
- Stock Control
- Manage the Finances of the Department
- Information Statistics Management
- Cash Control
- Pricing
- Merchandising and Space Management

The Parts Manager will report to the Dealer Principal or Aftersales Manager.
