Valetor

A Valetor is responsible for ensuring that the interior, exterior and engine compartment of new and used Vehicles are prepared to showroom standard. Applicants interested in pursuing a career in valeting and working as a member of a Valeting team within a dealership or valeting company and must be over 16 years of age. Applicants must also have a minimum requirement 5 Passes in Ordinary Papers at Junior Certificate level or equivalent qualifications or relevant valeting experience.

The primary tasks of a Valetor are as follows:

- Complete wet working including washing exterior, engine compartment, wheel arches, door ledges and any other relevant bodypart.
- Dry off Vehicle
- Steam clean and lacquer engine compartment
- Treat minor paintwork damage
- Hand wax Vehicle
- Treat rubber mouldings
- Clean exterior and interior windows
- Remove wax from Vehicle exterior
- Vacuum interior of Vehicle including ashtray, door compartments and boot area
- Shampoo seats and carpets
- Treat vinyl areas
- Undertake final inspection of Vehicle before delivery of Vehicle to customer or sales department

Valetors may work within a dealership or independently
